## 1. Applications

- 1.1. Complete an application to ACC

- 1.2. Complete a residency form
  - 1.2.1. Locate the form online
  - 1.2.2. Print out form
  - 1.2.3. Complete form
  - 1.2.4. Copy required residency documentation
  - 1.2.5. Make copies of all forms for your records
  - 1.2.6. Submit required forms to ACC admissions office: Mail original form and copies of required documentation to Admissions and Records, 5930 Middle Fiskville Rd., Austin, TX 78752-4390, or deliver a copy to an admissions office at any campus other than the one listed above, or Fax a copy to ACC admissions and Records at 512-223-7175 (Faxed copies must be accompanied by a photo copy of the front and back of your valid photo ID)
  - 1.2.7. International Students must contact the International Student Office for more information (512) 223-6247
  - 1.2.8. Early College Start students should submit their residency form to the advisors with other required documentation

#### 2. Transcripts

- 2.1. Secure required, official transcripts from previously attended educational facilities
  - 2.1.1. Contact your High School to request a transcript be sent to ACC prior to registration if this is your first college attendance
  - 2.1.2. Early college start students must bring transcripts to advising
  - 2.1.3. Contact all other colleges attended to request official transcripts to be sent to ACC prior to registration

- 2.1.4. If college transcripts are from a public institution in Texas they must have TSI status stated on the transcript
- 2.1.5. Provide proof of any applicable assessment scores such as SAT, ACT, TAKS, THEA, etc.
- 2.1.6. Provide copy of DD214 or active duty orders
- 3. Assessment requirements
  - 3.1. Identify required assessments
    - 3.1.1. Verify your status with student services and determine need for ESL assessment and/or OSD accommodations
    - 3.1.2. Secure a pass from student services or assessment office (as recommended by student services) for assessment
    - 3.1.3. Arrange payment for assessment
    - 3.1.4. Schedule required assessments to meet deadlines that apply if necessary
    - 3.1.5. Take required assessments
  - 3.2. Provide copies of assessment scores to the advisor
    - 3.2.1. Secure copies of assessment results
    - 3.2.2. Keep copies of results for personal records
    - 3.2.3. Take copies of assessment results to advising session
- 4. Advising
  - 4.1. Go to the advising office on any campus (except Highland Business Center)
    - 4.1.1. Verify documents required prior to the advising session (transcript official or unofficial, TSI status-(any tests scores), DD214, or active duty orders if applicable)
    - 4.1.2. Complete a check list to ensure all documents are in place prior to advising session.
