



Submitting Assignments

View Assignment • Attach Your Work • Save & Submit

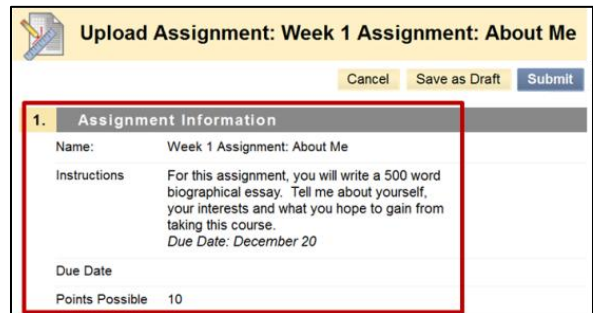
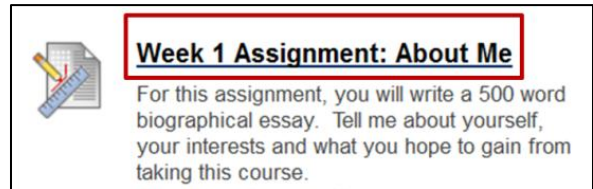


If your instructor is using Blackboard's assignment feature, you will be able to download and submit documents using an assignment link. Each instructor may choose to have you turn in your assignments differently, and not all instructors will use Blackboard's assignment feature.

View Assignments

1. Locate your assignment in your Blackboard course site. Click on the name of the Assignment.
2. In section 1, **Assignment Information**, you will see detailed instructions for the assignment, including Name, Instructions, Due Date and Points Possible.

Note: If you need to download a file your instructor has provided and then complete your work in that file, you will need to save the document to your computer first. Right click on the attachment link and select "Save Target As" or "Save Link As" from the menu.

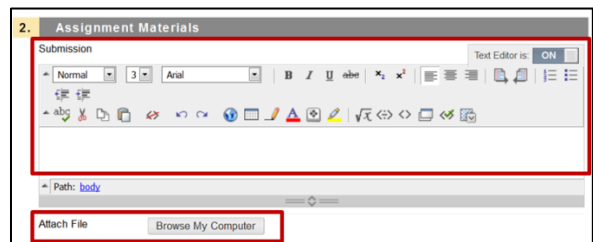


Attach Your Work

Once you have completed your work, go back to the assignment in your Blackboard course site and click on the name of the Assignment. Look for section 2, **Assignment Materials**, where you have two ways to submit your work:

1. Type or paste your work into the text box.
2. OR, if your work is in a separate document, you can click **Browse My Computer** to find and attach the file.

If you need to attach multiple documents, click **Add Another File**. You can remove any documents you have already uploaded by clicking **Remove** next to the document.



Note: Use only letters (A-Z, a-z), numbers (1-9), dashes (-) and underscores (_) when naming files. Do not use spaces, #, %, \$ or any other special characters. These characters can cause problems, and your instructor may not be able to open your file.

Save and Submit Assignments

1. If you need to continue working on your assignment later, click the **Save** button. This saves the work you have done so far and lets you come back to the assignment and complete it later. **Note:** *Clicking **Save** does not submit the assignment, and your instructor will not be able to view your comments or attachments until you have submitted the assignment.*
2. Once you have attached your files and/or entered your work into the text box, click **Submit**. The assignment is now complete and your instructor will be able to review your work.
