

VoiceThread is a cloud-based application that is integrated into Blackboard. VoiceThread enables asynchronous communication between students and instructor. Students and faculty will be able to watch, comment on, and create multimedia presentations that can be commented on asynchronously. Comments can be an audio or video recording or text-based – all of which can be created on the fly. Instructors can create graded VoiceThread presentations.



Students should see a VoiceThread activity or assignment in a content page in Blackboard.

1. Go to your Blackboard course and select the link for the voice thread. This will open a window where you can see an assignment or activity that's been created by the instructor.
2. Select the VoiceThread as instructed by your professor.
3. Students can
  - a. Create or select a VoiceThread, according to how the assignment/activity is structured.
  - b. Record comments on your VoiceThread for the Comment Assignment.
  - c. Watch the VoiceThread for the Watch Assignment.
4. You must always submit your work! When you submit your activity or assignment, your instructor will be able to track and review your work in VoiceThread.
